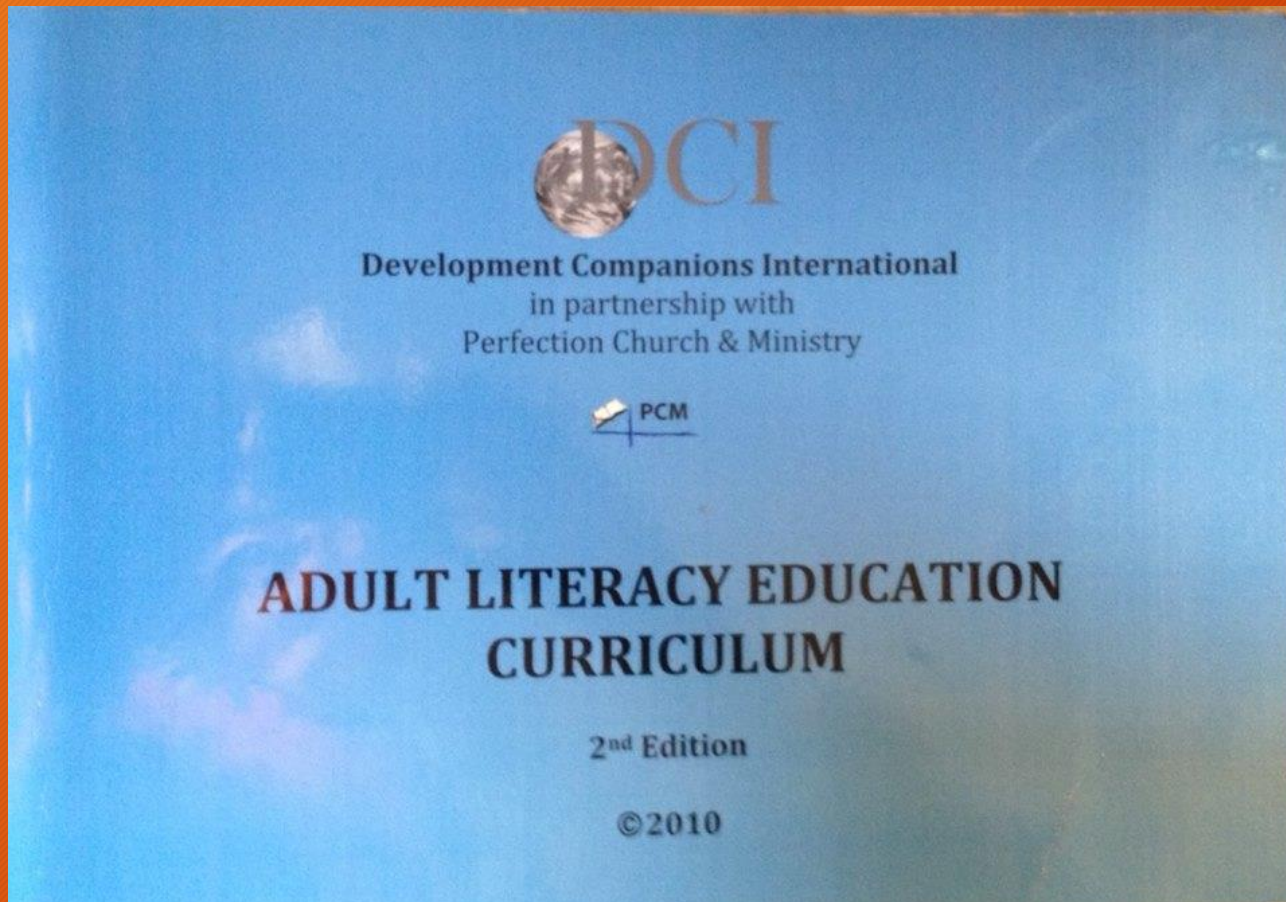

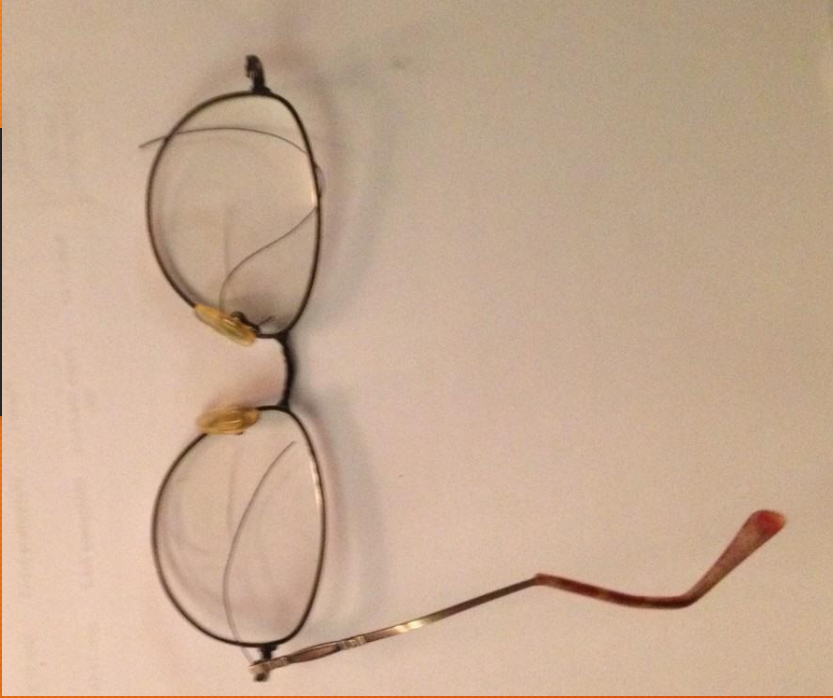


# Micro loan for Teacher Stephen
