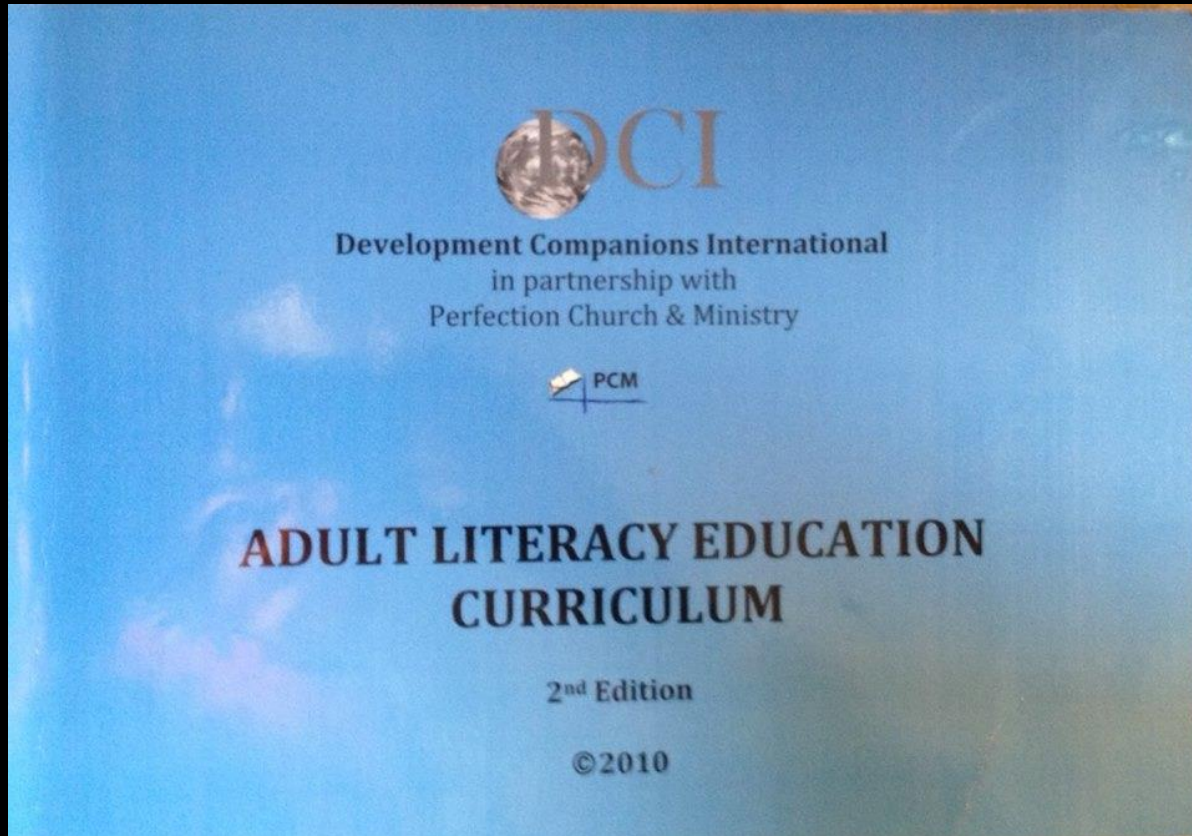

- New curriculum was developed in 2018 by our partner Development Companions International. This included a full rewrite of each section and the development of individual lessons. This makes each teacher consistent with all other literacy teachers in content of lessons.
- A huge undertaking.
- We are now implementing the new curriculum and the teachers are trouble shooting the lesson plans and testing to finalize a new and improved curriculum and teaching process.
- DCI will be printing a revised curriculum book. Life Seeds funded this project.
